# Instructions for abstract of Oral & Poster Presentation

## Guideline for Abstracts (Oral & Posters Presentations)

1. Please note that abstracts must be sent to the AASA office by no later than **28 February 2020**. Delegates will be notified by **10 March 2020** if their abstract(s) has been accepted.
2. All confirmed authors of orals and posters must register and pay their fees by no later than **28 February 2020** to be included in the official programme.

## Abstracts should be submitted as follows:

- TITLE OF ORAL/POSTER IN **BOLD CAPITAL LETTERS**.  
Name of the person who will be presenting (oral) or representing (poster), together with co-authors and the institution/business name of the first author (in regular font).
- Abstracts must be submitted in electronic (MSWord) format and in **Arial 10 pt font, single line** spacing.
- Abstracts must be in English and must not be more than 250 words (long abstracts will be returned for revision or truncated).
- The abstract should contain the main objective of your presentation, and the most important results and conclusions.
- Do not use pictures, graphs or tables.
- Use italics for genus and/or species names.

## Guidelines for Oral Presentations

- We have allowed 15-minute slots for all presentations. This includes time for questions, and we will only accommodate questions time allows it.
- Presentations must be prepared in PowerPoint (PP). To ensure compatibility, save your presentations in both newer (pptx) and older (ppt) file formats.
- All presenters must also make their presentations available to the conference technical assistant between 7:15am and 7:45am in the conference venue on the day of presentation.

## Guidelines for Poster Presentations

- Posters should be of size A0 or A1 and be in portrait format.
- There will be formal poster sessions during which time authors and/or representatives for these posters must be available to provide further details to delegates.
